

RESOLUTION 1-2006

WINDSOR REPORT 2004

WHEREAS, this 102nd Council of the Episcopal Diocese of West Texas desires to reaffirm the Diocesan commitment as previously resolved to remain, with The Episcopal Church (in the United States of America), “a constituent member of the Anglican Communion, a Fellowship within the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church, ...in communion with the See of Canterbury,” as provided by the Preamble of the Constitution of The Episcopal Church; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Diocese joins with our Bishop in committing to accept and live within the framework of the *WINDSOR REPORT 2004*, recognizing our interdependence and responsibility as members of the Anglican Communion, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Diocese urges the 75th General Convention of The Episcopal Church in the United States of America to reaffirm its constitutional obligation to continue a constituent member of the Anglican Communion, in communion with the See of Canterbury, through an unequivocal acceptance of and compliance with the findings and recommendations of the *WINDSOR REPORT 2004*, recognizing the very real possibility and the dire consequences otherwise of “walking apart” from our sister churches in the Communion.
